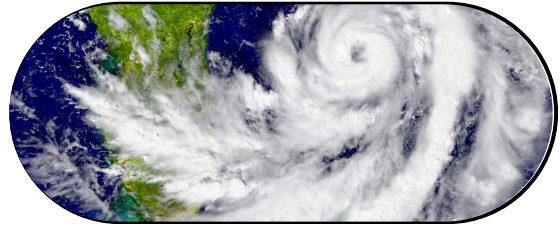


# Disaster Supply Checklist



## GENERAL

- Cash - ATMS may not have power
- Medications - list of & 2-week supply
- Batteries
- Flashlights - do not use candles
- NWR - battery/manual weather radio
- Cell phone chargers
- Car's gas tank should be full
- Rain Gear - umbrella, poncho or jacket
- Outerwear - Boots and Gloves

## FIRST AID

- Adhesive Bandages/Ace Bandages
- Antibiotic Ointment
- Hydrogen Peroxide/Rubbing Alcohol
- Matches/Lighter
- Tweezers and Scissors
- Over-the-counter Medications
- Hearing Aids/Glasses/Contacts/etc.
- Hand Soap/Anti-bacterial Wipes
- Mosquito Repellant and Sunscreen

## DOCUMENTS

- Insurance cards
- Medical records
- Banking information
- Credit card numbers
- Copies of social security cards
- Copies of birth and/or marriage certificates
- Other personal documents
- Set of car, house, and office keys
- Service animal I.D., veterinary records, and proof of ownership
- Copy of Will
- Copy of Passport
- Home Inventory Photos

## FOOD/WATER

- Nonperishable packaged/canned food
- Water - 1 gallon per person per day
- Non-electric can opener
- Special dietary items (babies, elderly)
- Plastic/Paper Dinnerware and Cutlery
- Pet food/dishes
