



American Society of Trace Evidence Examiners Student Research Project Award Application Form

The American Society of Trace Evidence Examiners (ASTEE) is offering a \$250 research award for undergraduate or graduate students that are performing research specifically in the field of Trace Evidence.

Eligibility Requirements: The applicant must be pursuing a Bachelor's of Science or higher degree in the natural sciences or forensic sciences.

Application Requirements: Applicants shall submit a completed ASTEE Student Research Project Award Application Form and an essay 1000 words or less detailing how the research is related to Trace Evidence, how it will benefit the Trace Evidence community and why they should be considered for this award. The application shall also include a completed Student Research Project Supervising Faculty Recommendation Form and a supervising faculty member letter of recommendation. The award winner shall report the results of their research to the ASTEE Board of Directors within one year of being granted the research award. The award winner is encouraged to publish their research in the Journal of the American Society of Trace Evidence Examiners (JASTEE).

Failure to submit the results of this research to the ASTEE Board of Directors within one year of being granted the award will require the award winner to return the \$250 research project award to ASTEE.
